Oorsprong en acties

- In reactie op de beslissing van President Trump lanceerde de NL Minister Plumen in februari het initiatief *She Decides* om de financiering te compenseren
- Minister De Croo sluit zich hier onmiddellijk bij aan
- De bedoeling is dat de *getroffen organisaties* hun werk op het terrein **verder kunnen zetten**
- **Geen** nieuw institutioneel mechanisme en **geen** nieuw fonds

- Website met een **crowdfunding platform** ; het geld wordt beheerd door de NL NGO Rutgers
- De **Brussels International Conference ‘She Decides’** is een **initiatief van Minister Alexander De Croo**. Nederland, Denemarken en Zweden waren co-organisator
- Bedoeling : **funding** en **advocacy**
- De conferentie ‘She Decides’ moet een **formeel startpunt** vormen voor een brede beweging die de volgende jaren de rechten van meisjes en vrouwen hoog op de internationale agenda houdt
- **53 landen** waren vertegenwoordigd, waarvan 21 op ministerieel niveau

Een conferentie... en daarna ?

- Meer dan 450 deelnemers
- **UNFPA Executive Director** Babatunde Osotimehin, **UN Women Executive Director** Phumzile Mlambo-Ngcuka, **WHO Assistant Director General** Flavia Bustreo, **Deputy High Commissioner for Human Rights** Kate Gilmore, **UNAIDS Director of Human Rights and Gender** Luisa Cabal, **Europees Commissaris Mimica**, **EEAS Principal Advisor on Gender** Mara Marinaki en de **Vice-President van het Europees Parlement** Ulricke Lunacek waren aanwezig.
- De belangstelling vanwege de **civiele maatschappij** was overweldigend

- In totaal werd tijdens de conferentie **181 miljoen euro financiële steun** toegekend voor SRHR. De donoren beslissen zelf hoe ze deze fondsen besteden, dwz via hun bestaande kanalen.
- Voorlopig is **nog niet beslist** naar welke organisatie(s) dit geld zal gaan.
- Voorstel gelanceerd om een **Group of Friends** (SRHR) op te richten
