



## The Major Gaps we observed

#### **Key gaps in inclusion-**


- Fewer or no engagement of allied health professions except medical students and nurses (e.g. Clinical psychology, speech and language therapy, occupational or physiotherapy, medical assistants, dentistry, CHWs, midwifery, local and indigenous professions such as Ayurvedic, Homeopathy, traditional healers)
- Challenging Integration of PH education into so many specialized clinical curricula
- Institutional and national political bureaucracy
- Poor internal integration and little external cohesion in medical education

#### Profound inequality across disciplines-

- Colonial distribution of initiatives and thoughts
- Unfair resource allocation
- Variable perception and awareness among HCPs
- Poor policy and governance in global south
- Inadequate public enagement with clinicians regarding 'Planetary Wellbeing'

'Apart from success stories, there is a noticeable lack of knowledge and resource equity between the Global South and North. The majority of the available PH courses and discussions of curriculum development, presented in this article, have emerged from high-income countries'-Asaduzzaman et al 2022

'Similar previous concepts, such as One Health, have been developed with an inequitable focus on animal health whilst neglecting the public health and environmental perspective'-Lerner, H. et al; Front. Vet. Sci. 2017

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#### Recommendations

#### Focusing on-

- Faculty development
- Public and professional awareness
- Dedicated network building of motivated HCP leaders and regional hubs with a strong political agenda

#### Involvement of-

- Students and trainees in development and implementation of curricula
- Civil societies, politicians and professional bodies e.g. Medical/Dental associations

#### Implementation of-

- Patient-oriented PH management (e.g. Basic course for all general practitioners around the globe)
- Universal planetary health module for all healthcare professionals
